Solution For Foreign Currency Checks

As we pointed out last quarter, the Federal Reserve Financial Services (FRFS) announced its intent to sunset the Foreign and Canadian Check Service by the end of 2026. Foreign and Canadian Check Services will accept forward items deposited until **December 4, 2026**.

Over the past few months, our Operations team has been working hard to integrate these services into Premier View, so it would be available for our credit unions beyond 2026. That work was just completed, and the CXI platform is available for your credit union to use with a single sign-on within Premier View.

We are excited about this integration as the platform is easy to navigate, and you can meet all your international money services needs in one stop! The banner on the following page is now displayed on Premier View.

In 1932

Roy F. Bergengren met with U.S. Senator Morris Sheppard of TX to discuss the need to organize credit unions under federal law.

Bergengren believed that a U.S. law permitting federal credit unions to organize was imperative. "A federal credit union law would be a sort of blanket insurance policy for all our state laws, giving us an alternative method of organization," Bergengren wrote. In June of 1934 President Franklin D. Roosevelt signed the Federal Credit Union Act into law.
